

STEALTHY SPECIES

SNOW LEOPARD SAFARIS, LADAKH

Come December and one of the most beautiful creatures descends into the lower reaches of the Trans-Himalayan region for the winter. Amid the craggy cliffs of Hemis National Park, a flash of movement catches your eye and the Snow Leopard makes its move, pouncing on it's prey like a flash, as your breath catches in your throat. Stealthy and secretive, the Snow Leopard is a master in the art of camouflage, moving like a wraith through the snowy landscape.

For wildlife photographers and enthusiasts, observing the Snow Leopard is an unrivalled experience. There are only a handful of these magnificent felines left, as they are a critically endangered species, and Hemis National Park is one of the last remaining natural habitats for this species in the world. There's a charm to Ranthambore that is utterly unique. A rugged wilderness, with a river rushing through, ruined ramparts of erstwhile fortresses and palaces, and a magnificent ancient temple in the midst of scrubby, undulating wilderness — this is home to some incredible wildlife, most notably the tiger. Ranthambore is famous for its tiger sightings, but this feline is not the only carnivore in the park. You may spot leopards as well as the fearsome gharial, which lurks on the banks of the river, waiting for its unsuspecting prey.

Sightings are excellent in Ranthambore and the landscape is picturesque. An abundant prey base means that there is plenty of food for the felines, particularly for mothers with young cubs. You will also see a whole host of deer, monkeys and birds, as well as reptiles and smaller herbivores and carnivores. As you travel through the park, you will likely hear the unmistakable call of a Barking Deer or the hoot of a monkey, warning the forest that a predator is on the prowl.



#01 E-Visas for UK travelers


The latest developments state that travelers of UK origin will soon be able to apply for an e-visa online, taking the hassle out of the paperwork and putting India back on the globetrotter's map.
