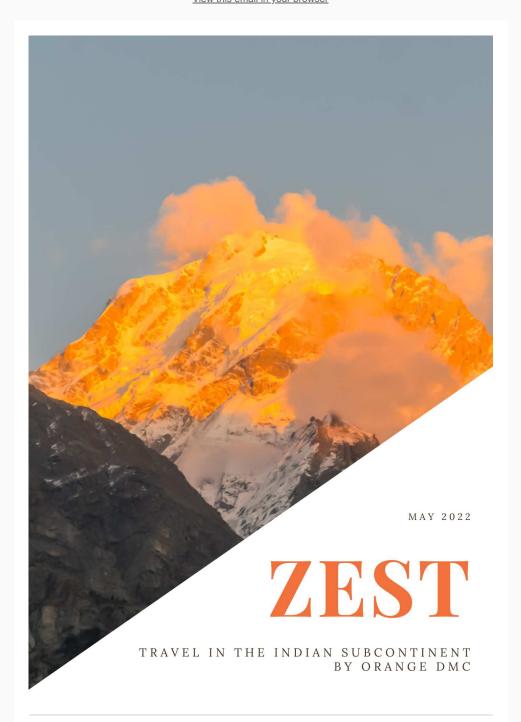
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SO COOL!

- Beach bliss: The Maldives is always on our mind.

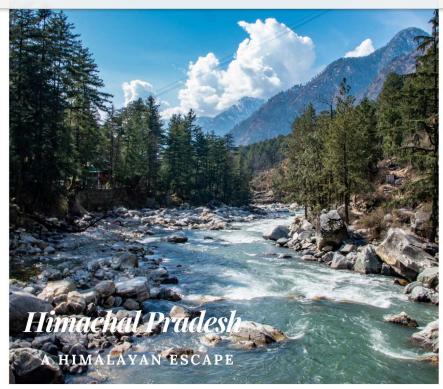
So pack those suitcases and pull out that passport. It's time to head over to our corner of the planet and drift away on your dream holiday.

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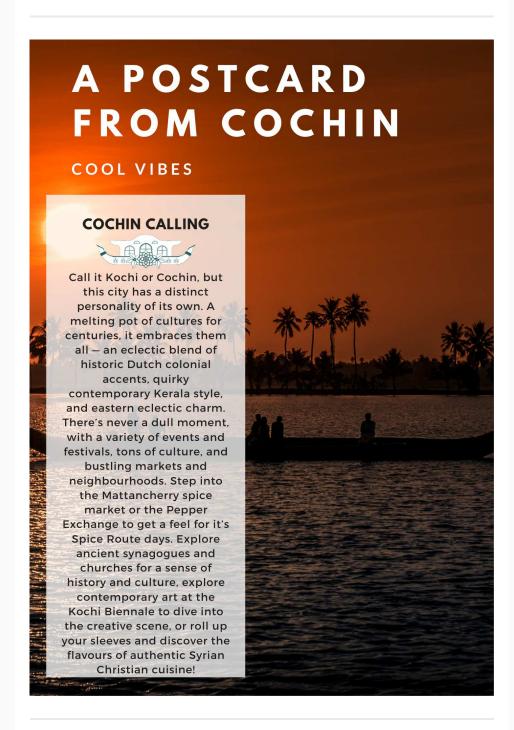
DHARAMPURA HAVELI

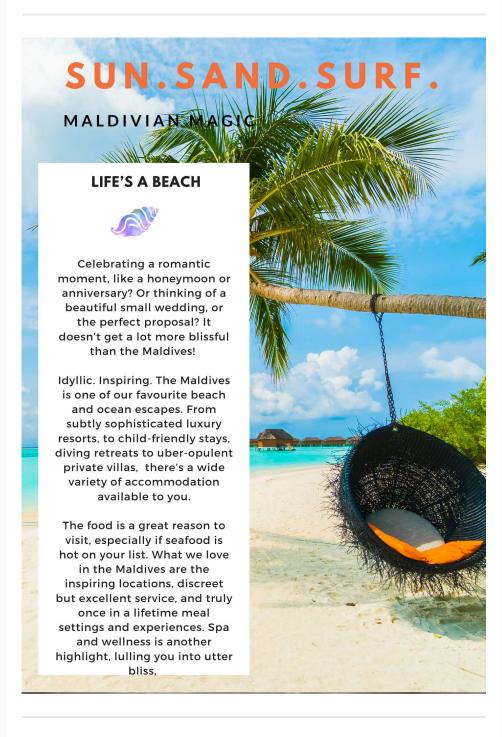


SHREYAS YOGA RETREAT
